

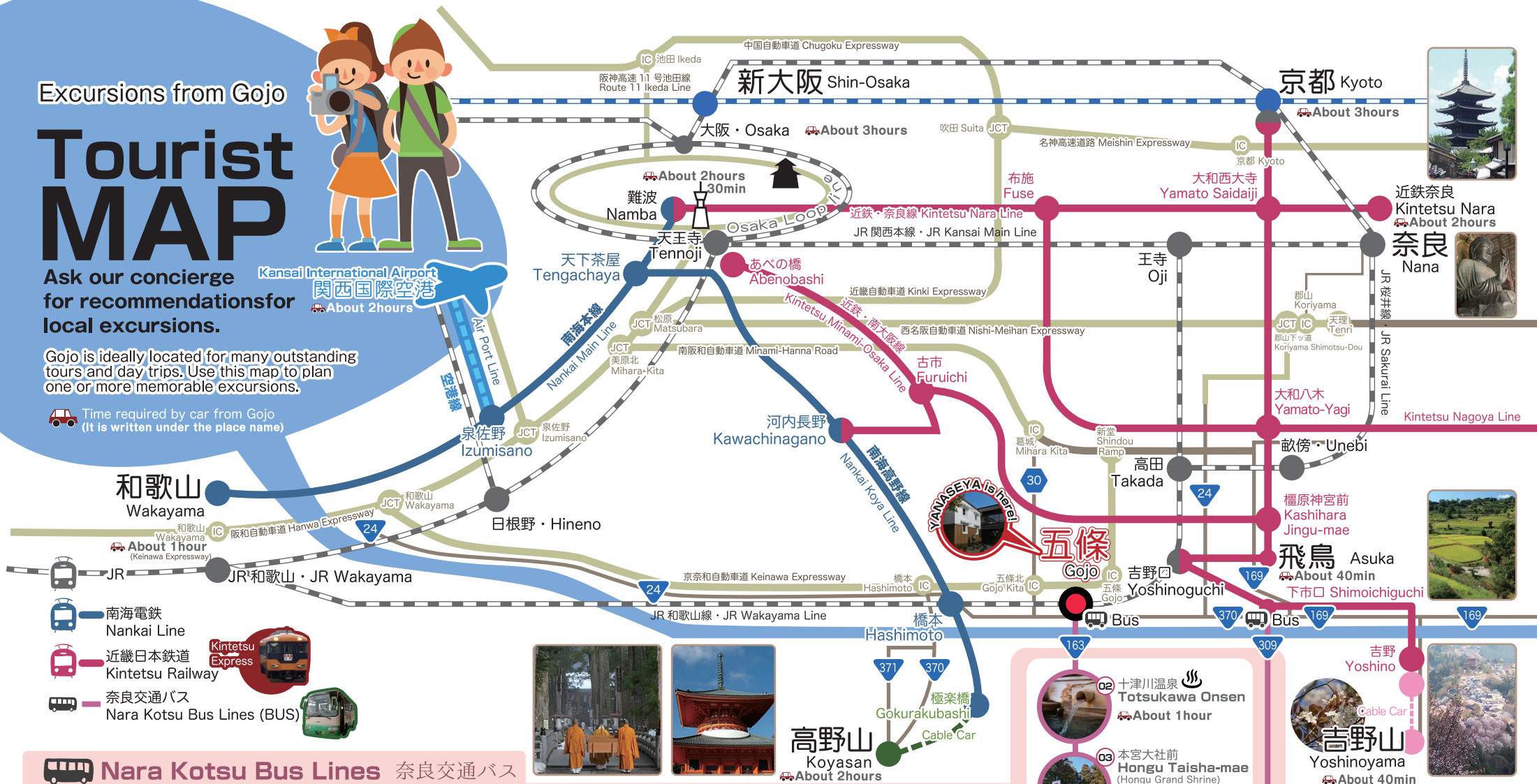

## Nara Kotsu Bus Lines 奈良交通バス

### Japan's longest bus route YAGI-SHINGU BUS

The Yagi-Shingu bus line is renowned as the longest bus route in Japan that does not operate on an expressway. It has a total of 167 stops along its 167-km route. The bus runs through Totsukawa-mura, which is said to be Japan's largest village, as well as the world heritage site known as "Sacred Sites and Pilgrimage Routes in the Kii Mountain Range." This area is also known for its hot spring resorts, which are relatively unknown to those who pass along this route.

#### Bus tickets

The "bus hike" (hiking ticket) for the No. 168 bus is convenient for those who wish to sightsee in Gojo, Totsukawa and Kumano. This ticket is also useful for those embarking at Yagi Station - Gojo Bus Center and disembarking from Tentsuji onward.
